

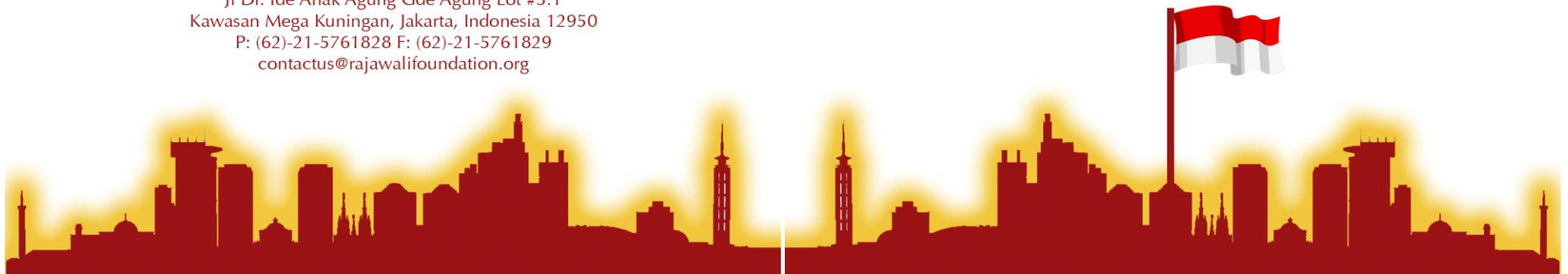

RAJAWALI FOUNDATION

The Rajawali Foundation (RF) was founded in 2010 as the philanthropic arm of Rajawali Corpora, a diversified Indonesian investment company. RF was founded by Peter Sondakh, the Chairman and CEO of Rajawali Corpora, to create a new funding mechanism in support of sustainable social development in Indonesia. The foundation's emphasis on education reflects Mr. Sondakh's view that knowledge, skills and creativity are the true foundations of equitable and sustainable economic development.

MISSION STATEMENT

The mission of RF is to promote peace, prosperity and the conservation of Indonesia's natural heritage through support for research, education and training. RF is a non-profit philanthropic organization that pursues these goals through partnerships with Indonesian and international institutions and with local communities.

RF has identified public policy training and research as a priority area of support owing to the potentially large impact of even small improvements to policy on the life of the Indonesian people. RF works with international and domestic partners to learn lessons from successful policy innovations in Indonesia and around the world, and to share these lessons with Indonesian policy makers, researchers, students and the general public.

RF therefore concentrates its resources on the following activities:

- Support for research and education to promote evidence-based policy making;
- Partnerships with academic institutions, government agencies, civil society organizations and community groups to learn lessons from best practice and share these lessons through training and other forms of outreach;
- Targeted support for groups and individuals to develop, implement and evaluate policy innovations that promote social harmony, prosperity and environmental sustainability.

PROGRAM & ACTIVITIES

RF maintains a diverse portfolio of projects and programs emphasizing policy research and education. Notable RF initiatives include the following:

- Rajawali Foundation Institute for Asia (RFIA), Harvard Kennedy School: RFIA supports public policy scholarship and networks in Asia, including research, fellowships and conferences drawing on the Harvard Kennedy School's global knowledge.

- Harvard Kennedy School Indonesia Program (HKSIP): The Indonesia Program sponsors scholarships, research, fellowships and executive education, including the annual Transformation in Leadership Program for local officials, including district heads and mayors, and their planning heads.
- Center for Public Policy Transformation ("Transformasi"): Transformasi is a newly established Indonesia-based independent center for policy research and education. Its mission is to conduct research relevant to public policy issues in Indonesia and provide executive education to government officials and other policy related professionals. Transformasi works closely with other policy research and education institutions in Indonesia and abroad to build policy networks and to close the gap between policy makers and scholars.
- Strategic Philanthropy – Promoting Indonesia's Research Culture: Together with the Research Triangle Institute (RTI) and United in Diversity, RF provided support to a forum designed to create a new network of philanthropists and high impact social investors who understand the importance of collaborating to promote the culture and practice of strategic philanthropy as a mechanism for stimulating and modernizing Indonesia's Knowledge Sector.
- Community Projects: Support renovation and maintenance of government public housing for flood victims and disadvantaged Jakartans. RF also supports schools for disabled and underprivileged children and contributes to disaster relief efforts and other charitable activities in the community.
- Indonesia Scholarship and Research Support Foundation (ISRSF): ISRSF is an innovative program that identifies promising young social scientists and gives them an opportunity to pursue advanced studies at Northwestern University in Evanston, Illinois. Arryman Fellows (AF) spend a year in preparatory courses and perfecting their English. Successful AF are invited to apply for the Arryman Scholarship Program, which supports doctoral studies at Northwestern University.
- Equality, Development and Globalization Studies (EDGS) at the Roberta Buffett Center for International and Comparative Studies at Northwestern University: EDGS promotes research, publications and public dialogue on issues confronting the developing world.
- University of Cambridge Development Studies Center: The Rajawali Foundation has provided support to the Development Studies Center to offer teaching at the post graduate level on development issues in Southeast Asia.
